USA Power Wheels Rules & Entry

POWER WHEELS FOR KIDS

POWER WHEELS for KIDS RULES – Parent/Guardian must read rules and sign waiver for child to participate. Parents & pit crew members must be able to provide proof of age and picture ID – driver's license or state issued photo ID. This must be done at every event that he/she will be entering pit area – no exceptions. Signing of the waiver gives UMS and USA permission to use any pictures taken for media purposes. Parent or guardian must supervise children at all times during event.

IMPORTANT RULES FOR 2025:

No Razor type dirt quads or air filled tires, hard plastic tires only. If in question of this rule please call the office.

If UMS or USA feels Power Wheel has been modified to be faster than stock it will be disqualified other then a drill battery This is for fun for the kids!

RULES

- 1. Open to kids ages 3 10. You must provide your own Power Wheels vehicle.
- 2. Power Wheels must be registered 1 hour prior to show.
- 3. Must have helmet. Elbow pads recommended.
- 4. All Power Wheels vehicles after registration, must be put in the designated area assigned by UMS or USA staff.
- 5. Secure doors and hood so that they do not come open. Bungey cord or zip ties recommended.
- 6. Seat belts are not mandatory but are recommended.
- 7. No special reinforcements must be the way Power Wheels was bought from store.
- 8. All Power Wheels must sit in not on store bought. no raising or lowering of the front or rear of the Power Wheels no making custom bodies must be stock.
- 9. Stock battery can be replaced with a 12v mower or drill battery. It can be positioned any where inside the car except for the passenger seat, it must be secure and covered.
- 10. Must be stock motor that came with vehicle, no motor upgrades.

- 11. No screws, Velcro or anything else may be attached to tires, must be stock plastic tires.
- 12. Event could consist of either Off Road Derby, Demo Derby or Figure 8 depending on the event at the show.
- 13. Power wheels entry is free with pit pass purchase.
- 14. Awards will be given out.
- 15. Most be sit-in style with side protection.
- 16. Rules & dates are subject to change without notice. THE DECISION OF THE JUDGES, SCORE KEEPERS AND OFFICIALS WILL BE FINAL!

At time of registration parent/guardian of child must sign a waiver and release of liability and indemnity agreement. Parent/guardian must supervise and be with child at all times when in the pit area. These rules will govern all Unique Motor Sports and USA demo events. All participants must comply with these rules and regulations, it is furthermore agreed that all entries, pit crew, driver, owner, sponsors, safety personnel, and law enforcement will comply with these rules. No expressed or implied warranties of any kind. This is a guide set forth for the conduct of the sport and no way a guarantee against injury or death to the spectator,

participant or official.

At any time during a UMS or USA event a driver and/or pit person(s) can be asked to leave event for any reason. Unique Motor Sports and USA demo have the right to accept or reject any entrees without notice.
